Here is the example I asked Richard to write.

Name of the game:- Floormula 1.

Type of game:- Made up.

How to play it:- When I was young I loved motor racing, I still do. I had lots of toy racing cars, just like the ones in the picture below. To play races, I would find a pack of playing cards and a dice. I would lay the playing

cards out in a sort of track, a bit like the picture on the right, and line all the cars up at the start. Then I would roll the dice and move the first car that number of playing cards along. I would do that, in turn, for all the remaining cars. Then I would go back to the leading car and roll again,



then for the second and so on. The leading car always went first but if they got a low number they could be overtaken so another car would be first next time. I would decide how many "laps" the race would be and the first car to cross the finishing line was the winner.

Why you like it:- It was fun and kept me amused for hours on days when I couldn't play outside. When I travelled around the coast for the first time in 1985, my eldest son, who was 8 then, used to set this game up in some of the houses we stayed in.
